New Printing Options for Mailing Labels.

Improved label printing options for all project mailing labels now allows users to specify which Row and Column they desire to mailing labels to print. Partially used label sheets can now be fully used.

Another enhancement to PreLien2Lien is the Backup function. You can choose in SETUP/DEFAULTS/ INPUT DEFAULTS to

Backup PreLien2Lien every time you close it to single file, or to have a new backup file created automatically upon exiting the program.

Improved Notary Options allows for easier use.

Another update to the software includes improved Notary options. Users can now specify Notary information outside of the state where the project occurred. Additionally, Notary Verification was added as an easy ON/OFF option for all template states.

New product for Lien Services. PreLien2Lien-LS

Many of the leading Lien Service companies across the U.S. use PreLien2Lien on a daily basis to produce notices for their customers. PreLien2Lien-LS is a new product slated for release on September 4, 2007 that incorporates web based data entry pages that are integrated with PreLien2Lien. Pricing is slated to be \$1,200 per year.

The software development schedule to include other states to have Custom Template Technology is as follows: August (Texas, Ohio), September (North Carolina, Georgia) and October (Indiana, Minnesota). HOW TO: ELECTRONIC SIGNATURES

PreLien2Lien now allows you to include your own, auto-generated, personalized electronic signature on any of our template state documents (currently includes: AK, AZ, CA, CO, FL, MI, MT, NJ, NV, OR, WA and WI). Creating a electronic signature is simple, and the result will save you the valuable time of not having to sign every copy of a particular type of notice you regularly create.

For a one-time \$50 fee, we will create a representation of your signature that integrates easily with our software. As notices require changes due to legal changes in state law, your template will be upgraded FREE of charge.

All we need is a copy of your signature to begin the process; just follow these steps to create a high-quality scan of your signature which we can then incorporate into the necessary document:

- Launch the program you typically use for scanning.
- Within the settings or preferences menu make sure 1-bit mode is selected (black & white line-drawing quality, NOT black & white photo quality which prints on a grey scale instead of true black and white).
- Match resolution dots per inch (dpi) to that of your printer's normal settings (usually 300 or 360).

- Sign your name using a black pen on a blank sheet of white paper. Place face down and scan.*
- Crop signature as needed, minimal white space along edges of signature is preferable.
- Save your scanned image as an uncompressed bitmap format, such as TIFF or BMP.

***Troubleshooting:**

If your resulting image is not to your satisfaction (breaks in line, rough edges, etc.) try the following solutions:

- Adjust the brightness settings.
- Use a higher dpi multiple.
- Press more firmly when signing or use a pen with a thicker tip.
